Yilabara, a Dharug and Iyora word for 'now', is a not-for-profit Aboriginal organisation designed to increase access to employment and training for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples. Our sole purpose is to create opportunities and make a difference. Yilabara's Barranggirra teams are based in NSW across Western and Sydney regions.

## Barranggirra

Barranggirra, a Wiradjuri word for 'to fly', 'arise', provides end-to-end support to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander learners through culturally appropriate mentoring to ensure successful retention and completion of training and improved post-training employment outcomes.



## Our Objectives

Yilabara's Barranggirra team will aim to achieve the following objectives

-  Increase access, retention and completion of vocational education and training
-  Build aspirations and expectations of career pathways
-  Improved post-training outcomes
-  Increase placement in meaningful and sustainable employment
-  Greater confidence in making decisions that maximise training and employment experiences and outcomes, and
-  Greater opportunities for Aboriginal business ownership and economic independence.

## What We Offer

Yilabara has a dedicated Barranggirra team that works with both the learner and employer.

Our services are completely voluntary with no associated costs.

We work directly with learners to develop individual mentor plans and offer cultural mentoring support, training and updates on trainee and apprenticeship initiatives.

We also work with employers who are actively engaged or interested in employing Aboriginal learners through a traineeship or apprenticeship.

Our goal is to provide a wrap around service for Aboriginal trainees and apprentices across Western and Sydney regions of NSW.
